



BANGKOK JUNIOR BASKETBALL LEAGUE TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All Divisions will play a 5-game Round Robin with each team playing every other team in the division. The teams will then be ranked accordingly.
2. All games will comprise four 5-8 minute quarters. 1 minute break between quarters. 2 minute break at halftime. No mid-quarter breaks.
3. One 30-second time out per game.
4. Clock stops for free throws throughout the game and for play stoppages in the last minute of the game.
5. No overtime in the case of a tie.
6. All players must play 2 quarters (subject to disciplinary action being taken against players for poor attendance or other league rule infractions). No other substitution rules apply.
7. In the event that a team cannot field 5 players, the game will be played 5 on 4. A team which cannot field 4 players shall forfeit the game and a mixed team scrimmage will be arranged by the coaches for the remainder of the session.
8. If a coach plans to "dock" game time from a player for poor attendance or other league rule infractions, they must first contact Coach Ike (ike@topflightbangkok.com) before the tournament game day.
9. Games are to begin no later than 5 minutes following the posted time. Game clocks will begin on- time; regardless of whether teams are on the court (i.e. games will be shortened if teams are not ready to play on time).
10. Coaches are responsible for getting their players to the proper courts on time for each game.
11. All other league rules apply.
12. Team with best record wins.

Tie breaker rules:

- a. Overall tournament record.
- b. Head-to-head record for tied teams (best record wins).
- c. Best defense overall (allowing lowest points scored in all tournament games wins).
- d. Point differential (difference between points scored and points allowed) overall

Note: In case of any forfeits, calculations will based on average per game played (for point counting)
